FBR has developed a specialized Autism Team comprised of individuals who exemplify a level of expertise in the provision of autism services. This team works to ensure and enhance the quality of services, expand the continuum of care for those on the spectrum, and train clinicians to excel in meeting the individual needs of the children we serve. The Autism Team consists of Autism Directors, Regional Directors of Autism Services, and a Director of Family Support Services.

Our Director of Family Support Services, Catherine Hughes, is a parent of a child formerly diagnosed on the autism spectrum. WHO SHOULD ATTEND CAMP JOURNEY?

Camp Journey is for children ages 5-15 diagnosed on the Autism Spectrum or that have a similar diagnosis. The child must possess basic communication skills (of any mode), basic self-help skills, and a foundation of safety awareness. They also must be non-aggressive to others, and cannot have a history of elopement.



WHERE IS CAMP JOURNEY CURRENTLY OFFERED?

We have sites available across multiple counties, including Beaver, Bedford, Fayette, Somerset, and Westmoreland. We continue to explore the needs of other regions that may be in need of our specialized program.

Children are divided into two age groups:

- **5 years to 10 years old:**
Tuesday and Thursday
9am to 2pm
- **11 years to 15 years old:**
Monday, Wednesday, Friday
9am to 2pm

IS THERE SUFFICIENT, RELIABLE STAFF TO WORK WITH MY CHILD AT CAMP JOURNEY?

Absolutely! Our staff ratio will be 1:2 (or less), and all staff will be trained in how to work with children on the Autism Spectrum. FBR offers a comprehensive training program on Autism Spectrum Disorders.

A Program Supervisor will spend individual time with each child to assess progress and monitor a child's needs within each week.

All Specialized Autism Services at FBR are under the oversight of a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA). Our STAPs as well, are also closely monitored and supported by a BCBA to maintain the clinical integrity of the program. The BCBA makes onsite visits to each site during the summer to ensure that each child is receiving service based in the principles of Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA).

In addition, our Director of Family Support Services visits the camp to offer that "parent perspective" to our staff, as well as provide support to families enrolled in the program.

WHY SHOULD MY CHILD ATTEND CAMP JOURNEY?

We at Camp Journey have many goals for your children! We hope to increase their socialization skills, enhance their communication skills, and provide them opportunities for reciprocal interactions with their peers.

WHAT TYPES OF ACTIVITIES WILL BE AVAILABLE AT CAMP JOURNEY?

Parents will be provided with weekly schedules of activities that will coincide with weekly themes, including Cooperation, Making Friends, America the Beautiful, Trip to the Zoo, Theater, Exploring Our World and more!

DOES CAMP JOURNEY PROVIDE FIELD TRIPS FOR CHILDREN?

FBR may schedule a field trip(s) for the children of Camp Journey. Information will be provided to parents when field trips are finalized.

IS THERE TRANSPORTATION AVAILABLE FOR THE CHILDREN OF CAMP JOURNEY?

MATP transportation will be provided to and from Camp Journey in participating counties. However, parents are welcome to transport their children to and from camp if they prefer, or if MATP is not available in your area.

ARE MEALS PROVIDED AT CAMP JOURNEY?

Parents should supply their children with their own brown bag lunches each day. Snacks and tangible reinforcers will be provided by Camp Journey. Gluten-free and casein-free items will be available for children with dietary restrictions. Parents are welcome to send in their own snacks if they prefer to do so.
