FBR has developed a specialized Autism Team comprised of individuals who exemplify a level of expertise in the provision of autism services. This team works to ensure and enhance the quality of services, expand the continuum of care for those on the spectrum, and train clinicians to excel in meeting the individual needs of the children we serve. The Autism Team consists of Autism Directors (AD), and Regional Directors of Autism Services (RDAS).

WHO SHOULD ATTEND CAMP ENDEAVOR?

Camp Endeavor is for children ages 5-18 diagnosed on the autism spectrum or that have a similar diagnosis. Children who have communication, socialization, and/or behavioral challenges are welcomed to attend Camp Endeavor.

WHERE IS CAMP ENDEAVOR CURRENTLY OFFERED?

The camp is currently held in Indiana County. We continue to explore the needs of other regions that may be in need of our specialized program.

Camp is held Monday thru Friday from 9:00am-3:00pm.



IS THERE SUFFICIENT, RELIABLE STAFF TO WORK WITH MY CHILD AT CAMP ENDEAVOR?

Absolutely! Our staff ratio will be 1:1, and all staff will be trained in how to work with children on the autism spectrum. FBR offers a comprehensive training program on Autism Spectrum Disorders.

A Program Supervisor will spend individual time with each child to assess progress and monitor a child's needs within each week.

All Specialized Autism Services at FBR are under the oversight of a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA). Our STAPs as well, are also closely monitored and supported by a BCBA to maintain the clinical integrity of the program. The BCBA makes onsite visits to each site during the summer to ensure that each child is receiving service based in the principles of Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA).

In addition, our Director of Family Support Services visits the camp to offer that "parent perspective" to our staff, as well as provide support to families enrolled in the program.

WHY SHOULD MY CHILD ATTEND CAMP ENDEAVOR?

We at Camp Endeavor have many goals for your children! We hope to increase their socialization skills, enhance their communication skills, and provide them opportunities to increase their independence.

WHAT TYPES OF ACTIVITIES WILL BE AVAILABLE AT CAMP ENDEAVOR?

Parents will be provided with weekly schedules of activities that will coincide with weekly themes.

DOES CAMP ENDEAVOR PROVIDE FIELD TRIPS FOR CHILDREN?

FBR may schedule a field trip(s) for the children of Camp Endeavor. Information will be provided to parents when field trips are finalized.

IS THERE TRANSPORTATION AVAILABLE FOR THE CHILDREN OF CAMP ENDEAVOR?

MATP transportation will provide compensation to parents for transportation.

ARE MEALS PROVIDED AT CAMP ENDEAVOR?

Parents should supply their children with their own brown bag lunches each day. Snacks and tangible reinforcers will be provided by Camp Endeavor. Gluten-free and casein-free items will be available for children with dietary restrictions. Parents are welcome to send in their own snacks if they prefer to do so.
